


Musical symbols and notation



Notes of the keyboard




TEXTURE	How many instruments are playing, thick or thin, lots or few.
TIMBRE	The quality of sound produced, the instruments that you hear.
DYNAMICS	The volume of a piece of Music– Loud or quiet.
PITCH	How High or low a note is.
TEMPO	The speed of a piece of Music, how fast or slow. We will look at <b>ADAGIO</b> (slow) <b>ANDANTE</b> (medium) <b>AND PRESTO</b> (fast).

The stave is the five lines and spaces on which the notes are written. The higher up the stave the notes are placed, the higher the pitch.

SPACE NOTES

Treble clef *SPACE* notes spell the word **FACE**.
