

Exam Day – Important Information

✓	Arrive Early
	Aim to arrive at least 15 minutes before the exam start time. Leave
	a safety margin in case of travel issues.
	Bags
	Do not bring bags into the exam room. Leave them where
	invigilators instruct.
	Phones, Watches and Electronic Devices
	You must not have any of these on you (on or off) in the exam
	room. If brought to school, they must be stored as directed before
	entry. Possession can lead to disqualification.
	Unauthorised items, such as revision notes, must not be kept on you
	or under your desk.
ID	<u>Identification</u>
	Internal candidates are identified by invigilators using photo desk
	cards or school systems.
	Private or transferred candidates must show approved photo ID on
	request.
	<u>Equipment</u>
	Bring black pens (ballpoint), pencils, rubber, compass, calculator,
	protractor, ruler and any other writing equipment needed to do the
	exam in a clear pencil case/transparent plastic bag. Do not use
	gel/fibre-tip pens – they are easily smudged.
1234	<u>Calculators</u>
	Bring your own - DO NOT EXPECT THE SCHOOL TO BE ABLE TO
	PROVIDE YOU WITH A CALCULATOR.
	Remove any lids/cases/covers (especially if printed) and store
	them in your bag. Clear memories and activate exam mode if
	applicable.
	In the Room
	No talking or communication. If you need help, raise your hand for
	an invigilator.
	<u>Dress</u>
	Wear normal school uniform. Bring a jumper/layer as room
	temperatures vary.
<u>-</u>	Food and Drink
	Water bottles are allowed in the exam room, but they must be in a
	clear, label-free bottle. Keep it on the floor by your desk.
	Food is not generally allowed . If medically required, it must be quiet ,
	minimal, in a transparent container with no packaging - arrange in
	advance with the Exams Officer.
